## **Metrocare Receives Grant from the Kozmetsky Family Foundation**

**DALLAS, TX** – The Kozmetsky Family Foundation (Kozmetsky) recently announced Metrocare Services (Metrocare) as the awardee of a \$150,000 grant. Funding from Kozmetsky will support operational expenses of the Steven A. Cohen Military Family Clinic at Metrocare and a multi-purpose community room located inside the clinic.

“We are honored to be awarded the Kozmetsky grant for the first time in Metrocare history,” said Dr. John Burruss, CEO of Metrocare. “The Cohen clinic at Metrocare is a unique center in that we know the veteran need is significant in North Texas and we know the clinic is working hard to meet the need. This grant will make a difference in extending the ability to meet the need and make a continuing impact in our community.”

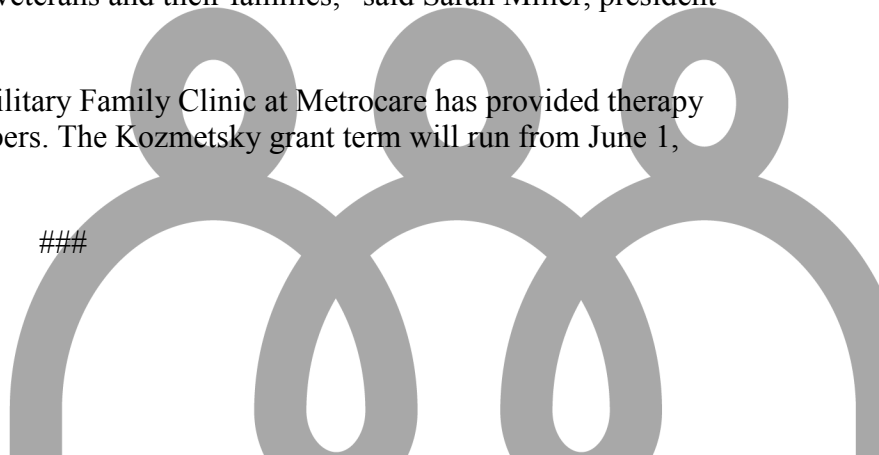
The Steven A. Cohen Military Family Clinic at Metrocare offers clinical services to post 9/11 veterans and their families, including individual, couples and family modalities, as well as group therapy. Many of the evidence-based interventions are offered via online therapy, allowing the clinic to reach more rural populations, and they also provide case management and psychiatric services.

The grant will also support a multi-purpose community room to accommodate more individuals during group therapy, staff meetings, area agency and veteran service organization meetings, veteran workshops, continuing education courses and become a veterans’ community “hub.”

“Kozmetsky Family Foundation is proud to partner with Metrocare Services to strengthen critically needed mental health services for North Texas veterans and their families,” said Sarah Miller, president of Kozmetsky Family Foundation.

Since opening in 2016, the Steven A. Cohen Military Family Clinic at Metrocare has provided therapy to over 1,500 unique veterans and family members. The Kozmetsky grant term will run from June 1, 2019 to May 31, 2020.
