Who We Serve

Residents of Dallas County, at least three years of age and has either a:

- diagnosis of an intellectual and / or developmental disability (IDD) or other related condition
- pervasive developmental disorder, like Autism Spectrum Disorder
- nursing facility resident who is eligible for specialized services for IDD or related condition.

Eligibility to receive services is determined by Metrocare's Eligibility Determination Unit.

Services Provided

When determined eligible to receive services, Metrocare coordinates supports like:

- Behavioral Support
- Community Support
- Day Habilitation
- Employment Assistance
- Nursing
- Respite
- Specialized Therapies (OT, PT, Speech)
- Vocational Training
- Coordination of Medicaid Services such as:
 - Community First Choice
 - Home & Community-Based Services
 - Preadmission Screening and Resident Review
 - Texas Home Living
